FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. - Q: How do I become a member of the Arizona Artists Guild (AAG)?

A: Visit the AAG Web site at www.arizonaartistsguild.org and click on join/renew in the column on the left. Download and print the AAG membership form by clicking on the thumbnail or by downloading the PDF version. Mail the completed form along with a check for \$40 to the address on the form.

2. - Q: I'd like to attend an AAG meeting before I join. Is that possible?

A: Yes, that is totally fine. You are welcome to attend an AAG meeting. Regular meetings are held at the AAG building located at 18411 N. 7th Ave., Phoenix, AZ 85023.

3. - Q: When and where are the AAG meetings?

A: AAG meetings are held on the third Tuesday of each month, September through April (no meeting in December), at 7:00 p.m. at 18411 N. 7th Ave. Phoenix, AZ 85023. Pre-meeting critique sessions begin at 6:00 p.m. Meetings feature an art-related program (demonstrations, slides, lectures, etc.), preceded by a short business / informational segment.

4. - Q: How do I sign up to receive AAG e-blasts?

A: Here's how:

1. Log on to www.arizonaartistsguild.org
2. Click Subscribe to e-mail blast (in orange print).
3. On that page, click below for a sign-up form at the bottom of the page.
4. Type in your e-mail address, first name, last name, and the Access Code. 4. Click Subscribe.

One final, important step...wait for a confirmation e-mail to be sent to your address.THEN, click to confirm

5. - Q: My e-mail address changed. How do I update this with the AAG so I can continue to receive e-blasts on newsletters, upcoming workshops, etc.?

A: When you change your e-mail address, please complete a new e-blast subscription form and confirm. Just follow the easy steps above.You also need to notify the membership chair so she can update the membership database: Laura Cohen-Hogan at creativeprojects@earthlink.net.

6. - Q: How do I go about submitting articles or announcements to the AAG Newsletter? When is the newsletter published?

A: The cycle of the AAG Newsletter is directly correlated with the AAG's art season, which runs from September to May. For example, the 2011-

2012 season is kicked off by the September 2011 newsletter, which is uploaded to the AAG's Web site the first week of the month. An e-blast to members follows shortly thereafter to let members know that the newsletter is uploaded to view at their leisure. This gives members roughly two weeks to download and read the newsletter before that month's AAG meeting on the third Tuesday. There is no AAG Newsletter in December.

You can e-mail newsletter submissions, articles, award announcements, JPEGs of your artwork, or advertising by the 20th of the prior month for inclusion in the following month's AAG newsletter. Please also remember to send all pertinent information regarding your acceptance into exhibits including, the title and medium of your artwork, as well as the complete name of the exhibit and the exhibit's city and state. No handwritten or phone submissions are accepted. All submissions and JPEGs of artwork are edited and cropped at the discretion of the editor.
