All artists are celebrated at a show and reception for their work at the September meeting.


AAG Community Outreach Fine Art Exhibitions

AAG's Outreach Art Programs

Since its inception in 1928, Arizona Artists Guild has promoted the arts through **education**, **exhibition** and **outreach**.

Community outreach is the cornerstone of the Arizona Artists Guild's activities and is the main focus of our organization. We recognize the impact that art has on people's lives and it's potential for facilitating healing which is immeasurable. AAG recognizes the value of the arts in how it enriches lives. Guild members and Outreach Program participants alike relate stories about how their lives were changed through their own exposure to Fine Art, be it at an early age or later in life when they could pursue a life long urge that had been repressed due to family and career obligations.

AAG provides tuition-free monthly art classes to underserved segments of our community who find an improved quality of life through making art.



Veterans Art Outreach Program: In recognition of the sacrifice made in service to our country, AAG has created a program to provide free art instruction for Veterans of US military service. This program meets on the fourth Saturday of the month to instruct and inspire.

The Mosaics: are groups of non-English speaking elderly immigrants who are isolated due to age and language. they are newer to the area and face the

challenges associated with creating new friends and building community. Their art becomes the common language and is often the only language spoken.

The Mona Lisas: AAG hosts art instruction to a group of young women who have endured sexual abuse and in some instances, trafficking. Due to the ages of the participants and the nature of the group, we do not publish details about this group.

Perennial Picassos: Arizona Artists Guild is partnering with Hospice of the Valley to bring an art program to their palliative care dementia patients.

Suicide Survivors: Arizona Artists Guild offers tuition-free art classes to Suicide Survivors. This program is designed specifically for friends and families who have lost a loved one to suicide as well as those who have attempted suicide and survived.



Ceramic Classes for Veterans

Arizona Artists Guild is proud to partner with Paradise Valley Community College to offer a ceramics program to Veterans' and their family members. The class is run by David Bradley and AAG members who help.



AAA Veteran Program This program is supported by AAG donations and funding from the Arizona Arts Alliance. It's designed to provide meaningful art instruction to Veterans of US Military Service for free.
